
The Indian Knowledge system (IKS) Division of the Ministry of Education at AICTE was established with a vision to promote interdisciplinary and trans-disciplinary research on all aspects of Indian Knowledge systems, preserve and disseminate IKS knowledge for further research and societal applications. IKS has come up with its new Internship programs for students of 18-30 years of age with 1000 openings.

The IKS internship program is designed to encourage youth to take up deeper study. The motto is to create opportunities for students to get involved and contribute to research. The applications for the internships are being called throughout the country. Selected candidates will be paired with IKS experts and are expected to work on short research projects, workshops, etc. as suggested by the experts.

To create a contextual framework for further research, the Ministry of Education (MoE) and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) are offering more than 1000 internships to students to explore Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) for a period of two months. The interns will work on short research projects, activities/workshops, etc. Their progress will be monitored through the monthly report submitted by them and their mentor's feedback. The interns will be encouraged to continue to work with the experts and advance the area of research through further collaborations even after the completion of the internship programme.
