

## UGC-NET EXAM

University Grants Commission National Eligibility Test (UGC NET) or NTA UGC NET is a national-level exam conducted in order to determine the eligibility of candidates for only Assistant Professor or both Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) and Assistant Professor posts in Indian universities and colleges. The UGC NET 2023 exam will be held for a total of 83 subjects. Until 2021, the NTA UGC NET exam was conducted for 83 subjects. The UGC NET syllabus differs for all 83 subjects and is prescribed by the University Grants Commission itself. Until June 2018, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) conducted the NET exam on behalf of UGC. However, from December 2018 onwards National Testing Agency (NTA) started conducting the UGC NET exam.

### UGC NET Eligibility 2023 – Educational Qualification

Candidates need to have the following educational qualification in order to be eligible to apply for the UGC NET exam:

Candidates should have secured at least 55 per cent marks in master's degree exams. A relaxation of five per cent is given to candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)/Other Backward Class (OBC)/Persons with Disability (PwD)/Transgender category. Therefore, candidates from reserved categories require only 50 per cent aggregate marks in their master's degree exams.

Candidates should have completed their post-graduation from a UGC recognised college/university in relevant streams such as Humanities, Social Science, Electronic Science, Computer Science & Applications, etc.

Candidates appearing in or awaiting results for their final year examination of master's degree are also eligible to apply online for the UGC NET exam. However, such candidates are admitted provisionally and are considered eligible only when they pass their master's exam with the required percentage. "Such candidates must complete their PG degree examination within two years from the date of NET result with required percentage of marks, failing which they shall be treated as disqualified", informs the official website.

PhD degree holders whose master's exams were completed on September 19, 1991 (regardless of the result declaration date) are eligible for a relaxation of five per cent marks in the aggregate i.e., only 50 per cent marks are required for such candidates.

**UGC NET 2023 Exam:** UGC NET Application Form 2023 for June cycle will be released by NTA on May 10, 2023, along with the notification. According to the latest tweet from UGC chairman M Jagadesh Mamidala, the National Testing Agency will release the UGC NET notification and applications for the UGC NET 2023 June cycle exam on May 10, 2023, on the official website. Candidates will be able to fill out the UGC NET Application Form 2023 from May 10 to May 31, 2023. UGC NET official notification PDF and UGC NET. The UGC NET 2023 June cycle will be carried out between June 13 to 22, 2023.

The UGC NET notification will comprise details like UGC NET 2023 June application details, eligibility criteria, syllabus, and more. The notification will be released by the NTA explaining

the steps to apply for UGC NET June cycle exam 2023. UGC NET application form 2023 comprises five sections that are personal details, educational qualification, Id verification, signature & photo upload, and application fees.

### **UGC NET 2023 Application Form**

The last date for filling out the UGC NET 2023 application form is January 17, 2023. NTA released the UGC NET 2023 application form on December 29, 2022, for the December Cycle 2022 on the official website. The candidates have to fill out the application form online. The application form was made available in online mode. To complete the UGC NET 2023 application process, candidates were required to upload scanned copies of their photographs and signature along with the payment of the application fee.

**UGC-NET coaching classes** are conducted by competent faculty on Saturdays and Sundays. Students who attended these courses have shown better performances in competitive exams and they have found it useful in their future research career.
