

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Affiliated college of the University of Calicut, having its office at Pongam, Koratty east, Thrissur – 680308

And
LITTLE FLOWER HOSPITAL
Angamaly, Ernakulam district, Kerala 683572
(Under Arch Diocese of Ernakulam-Angamaly having its office at Angamaly, Ernakulam district, 683572
(Hereinafter referred to as 'LF hospital).

WHEREAS NBS, Pongam, is an educational body engaged in education and interested to avail medical treatment facility for its Faculty, Students and Staff.

WHEREAS LF Hospital is a multi-specialty, hospital providing medical facilities in all the fields and specialties and agrees to provide medical facilities to the employees, and students of NBS, Pongam.

Now this MOU witness and it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. A written request for hospitalization should be made by NBS, Pongam. This request will be either faxed / e-mailed or hand delivered by the beneficiary and produced at the time of admission along with photo identity proof issued from NBS, Pongam. LF hospital will not provide credit facility without this letter. In emergency, the patient should be treated as per the hospital norms. However, the request letter will be submitted latest by next working day.
2. LF hospital shall provide medical facility to the students and staff members of NBS under emergency situations.
3. LF hospital will not provide cashless facility. The patient or NBS will pay cash and may avail insurance facility for the treatment after discharge.
4. NBS, Pongam will not be responsible for making payments for items such as special attendants charges, telephone, snacks, food and beverages etc. and must be directly collected from the beneficiary.


5. After the beneficiary is discharged from the Hospital, LF hospital shall submit the bill along with supporting documents to NBS, Pongam for reimbursement.
6. LF hospital shall furnish to NBS, Pongam the Detailed Schedule of Charges for various services and will keep informed about any revision in the charges, which may take place from time to time.
7. The NBS, Pongam beneficiary will be provided best possible treatment by the panel of consultants attached to LF hospital according to the practice parameters and clinical protocols established by LF hospital.
8. MOU can be terminated by either party by giving one month's prior notice.
9. Any disputes, claims arising out of this Agreement are subject to arbitration and subject to the jurisdiction of ERNAKULAM courts only.
10. Any clauses in the MOU can be affected as an addendum, after the written approval from both the parties.

Duration of agreement

The total duration of the MOU will be for three years (2nd December, 2019 to 1st December, 2022) after signing of agreement, renewable after three year. Any possible extension of the MOU will be based on the requirement .The extension and/or continuation will be based on mutually agreed terms.


